

# QUICK GUIDE TO PRAYING FOR YOUR HUSBAND

**HIS HEAD** - That he will look to the Lord for guidance, that he will stay focused, and that his thoughts will be renewed and transformed in God's power. (1 Corinthians 11:13, Romans 12:2, 1 Corinthians 2:16)

**HIS EARS** - That he will be sensitive to the holy spirit's prompting and be open to hearing God's still small voice. (1 Kings 19:12, Psalm 32:8, 1 Thessalonians 5:19, Isaiah 30:9)

**HIS NECK** - That he will be humble yet strong, obedient to God's word. (James 4:10, Joshua 1:8-9)

**HIS ARMS** - That God would give him strength and allow him to take delight in his work. (Psalm 73:26, Ecclesiastes 3:22)

**HIS RING FINGER** - That his marriage vows will be written on his heart and his love will never cease. (Proverbs 3:3, Malachi 2:16)

**HIS FEET** - That the Lord would guide his steps, walk in truth and flee from temptation. That he would pursue wisdom, peace, love and truth. (Proverbs 4:5-7, 25, Psalm 26:3, 2 Timothy 2:22, Psalm 34:14)

**HIS EYES** - That he will guard his eyes from sin and not put any worthless thing before him. (Matthew 6:13, Mark 9:47, Psalm 101:3)

**HIS MOUTH** - That he would only speak the truth in love and his words would be pleasing to the Lord. That no ugly talk would come from him, but only what is good. (Proverbs 19:14, Ephesians 4:15, 29)

**HIS HEART** - That he will love the Lord with all his heart and his heart will be tender towards his family. (Deuteronomy 6:5; Proverbs 3:5, Mark 12:30-31, Proverbs 5:18-19, Malachi 4:6)

**HIS HANDS** - That he will see his work as a gift and enjoy it. (Ecclesiastes 3:13, 5:19, Psalm 90:17)

**HIS LEGS** - That he will have strength, run with endurance, and not grow weary. (Psalm 62:6, Isaiah 40:31, Hebrews 12:1)
